They sent a team of 3 men, Joe, Kelly and Henry, they worked hard for 7 days and now our men here in Nicaragua are continuing the job.

Dear Friend and Partner,

For the last 30 years I have dedicated my life to preach the gospel and help the poor. In 1986, when I left the states I knew little about everything the Lord had in store for us to do for the sake of His name and Kingdom. I was only 32 years old and I knew no Spanish at all. I went to Costa Rica for a year to learn it and then I moved to be a fulltime missionary to Guatemala in 1987. I spent 11 years in Guatemala planting churches, feeding programs and a medical-dental clinic. The 2nd church I planted in San Miguel Escobar, Guatemala where I left my son as the pastor when I moved to Nicaragua full time in 1998 celebrated 27 years the month of February. I am so blessed to know that the Lord is faithful to continue His work in our lives. This month the 1st church I planted in Nicaragua while I was still leaving in Guatemala will be celebrating 19 years. All this wouldn't be possible without your faithful support during all this time.

- *Pray for me and my health and my family. I am planning on going to the states to do another medical checkup and we are believing for this: that I am healed and I walk in divine health.*
- *We requested 4 containers and we are praying and believing for the funds for these ones. Each container is a donation to us from them, but we need to pay the shipping which is U\$4,000 dollars each one. We need U\$16,000 dollars to cover all this. Pray about this. SPECIAL REQUEST: EMERGENCY

As you know, SAVE A GENERATION has its Headquarters offices and storage building in Managua. This is a property that belongs to the government. Here, we have the administration's offices, the storage for the food that we use for our feeding stations and the main

church that's seats 1000 people. We have to pay a fee of U\$5,100 dollars per month for this facility. The year of 2016 was a tough year for us and the church in Managua has been helping with the rent, but the Lord put in my heart to ask you for 500 people that can give U\$10.00 (ten dollars) extra per month to be able to pay for this fee. I am believing that this is an idea the Lord gave me and I want you to pray about helping us with this. 500 people giving U\$ 10.00(ten dollars) extra a month will make a huge difference and it will help us accomplished more and feed more children.
