Dear Friends and Partners:

The month of February has started out to be a great month for Nicaraguan people. School has started back and, with your help, we were able to give the children in our school new backpacks and school supplies.

We also started feeding in two more locations, Chinandega and El Viejo. More than 500 children will be receiving lunch in these villages. Now we are feeding the children in 18 villages in Nicaragua thanks to your support!

We had a medical and construction team here last week from Millennium Ministries (Founder Mike Craig) from Iowa. They were a great blessing. The doctors and nurses attended to over 800 people and worked in 6 different villages. The construction team put a new roof on the school library.

We have another team coming in this week from Iowa as well. They are also a medical and construction team. As you can see, we are off to a great start this year and there is much work to do.

I want to ask you for your help this year. Since we started *Save a Generation* back in 1990's we have been asking for \$20.00 a month to be able to feed a child and help them with medical and education costs. However the cost of these supplies and services has really gone up. I have not asked many people to increase their giving, but all of our costs continue to rise including the cost of gasoline, salaries for the school's teachers, wages for the doctor, wages for the nurse, electricity, etc.

I want to ask you if you could give \$30.00 per month or more. If you are unable to increase your monthly pledge, we certainly understand and appreciate your current pledge very much. Perhaps you have some friends that want to help sponsor a child. We have over 1100 children that need a sponsor. Although these children don't have a sponsor, we don't turn them away. Also, we are feeding the elderly widows which are a great blessing. Some of these ladies would go a day without eating without our help.

James 1:27 says, "Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress..". Whatever help you can offer by praying for us or bringing a team down to help for a week or helping financially, I know God will bless you richly.
