Each month I look forward to writing you. My prayers are with you as the 2010 year seems to fly by. April was another blessed month here for Save A Generation and I am blessed to be able to share with you what has been happening here in Nicaragua.

In the March newsletter, we added an important note to let each of you know we had been donated a container of the nutrient rich Feed My Starving Children Food. This container contains over 270,000 prepackaged meals! We asked that, if able, you would help contribute to the shipping costs. Because of you we were able to reach our goal and had the funds to ship the container of food to Nicaragua. I want to thank you for the additional support in a time of need. Feed My Starving Children loaded the container April 28th, and the container is now on the way to us.

This month, the Save A Generation employees updated the sponsored children in 5 more villages. We have only 6 more villages to complete the 2010 updates. I hope to have the remainder of the sponsored children updated in early May. I do apologize for the wait, but there are so many updates to be completed each year. You will receive the update on your sponsored child in the near future.

There is a great need for more child sponsors. Save A Generation is now feeding over 2,000 children.
