There is very exciting news to share this month. Save A Generation will be expanding its jurisdiction in faith! SAG is now in the process of expanding into South Nicaragua. Through out 2009 and 2010, my brother Ken and Amanda have become very involved in Save A Generation and in helping the people of Nicaragua. Together they collect donations, raise awareness of the need, and have brought many groups to Nicaragua. Ken and Amanda have visited many towns and villages through out Nicaragua and feel that South Nicaragua is where they would like to focus their Mission-Work and Mission-Vacation opportunities. The Lord has put on their hearts to start in and around the town of San Juan del Sur. They have visited this specific town many times, and although it is in a beautiful location, there is so much poverty and need there and in the surrounding areas.

The first mission for SAG in South Nicaragua is to assist a school in a village called Las Brisas. Ken and Amanda have met with the school director, Veronica, to discuss the specific needs in her region. Veronica is responsible for the seven schools in her region, and is also the Pastor of the Evangelical church's wife. There are 25 children ready to attend school in Las Brisas, but have no teacher to teach them. Raising the funds to pay the teacher her \$200 per month salary is first on the list of things to be done. School supplies, children's clothes, rain boots, and medical care are also on the list.

The long term goals of the SAG projects in South Nicaragua is to share the word of God and bring people to the Lord, teach healthy living and eating habits, introduce and grow Moringa trees in each village and educate the villagers the many benefits of all parts of the tree, and demonstrate the importance of education. It is very important to enable each village to self-sustain.

There will be Mission-Work trips available and Mission-Vacation trips available in the San Juan del Sur location. Ken and Amanda invite you to join them in South Nicaragua to share the word of the Lord and bless the people.

I want to explain the difference of each trip so that you can decide which opportunity is best for you. Mission-Work trips will include visits to villages to distribute donations, construction projects, farming projects, and medical out-reaches. Showing the people in the villages that it is because of Jesus Christ we are in Nicaragua. The majority of these trips will be spent in remote villages with the local people. A Mission-Vacation will include all of the above and some leisure time. San Juan del Sur is known for it's beautiful beaches, great surf, and tropical weather. There are also many activities such as a tree-top zip line, ATV rentals, horseback riding, and exploring a beach where sea turtles nest.

Either trip is a great opportunity to visit Nicaragua and help those less fortunate. The Lord has put it on Ken and Amanda's hearts to venture to South Nicaragua and bring groups to this location. Trips can accommodate people of any age and skill level. For \$90 per day all lodging, meals, transportation, translators, and mission supplies are covered. You will come back from the adventure a more appreciative person.
