Dear Partner and Friend,

Another blessed month with Save A Generation here in Nicaragua! We have kept you in our prayers through out the month. It is hard to believe it is already September.

Global Hope Ministries came to Nicaragua August 12th - 20th. During their trip they felt a need to purchase school supplies for the children that attend our school in Pascuala. School supplies were purchased and given to the 70 children at the school. They also purchased enough medicine to take our doctor to the villages of Torrez, Mata de Caña, Jicaro Bonito and Las Mesitas. They, along with Doctor Anderson and Hilda the nurse, did a great job attending the children and adults. Because of the rainy season the most common illnesses are Pneumonia, Bronchitis, and the flu. Global Hope Ministries also has plans to build a church in Las Mesitas in the very near future. On this trip they were able to meet with the Pastor of Las Mesitas to let him know that they are almost ready to start building the Church. They have been working hard on raising the funds and planning for this project.

The next large project SAG will be working on is re-opening the orphanage in Somotillo. The orphanage needs many repairs to meet the government standards. It will be called 'Casa Esperanza' meaning 'Hope House'. We plan to begin construction and remodeling towards the end of the month. Having this orphanage open will be such a blessing to so many children. We will be keeping you updated on the progress and opening. Please keep this project in your prayers.

Updates from the previous newsletter -

The Santa Cruz Cistern project: New pipe has been installed from the main water line to the cistern and water is now filling the cistern. This month we will be working on installing the pump on the cistern to pump the water to the water tower.
